



## Research Grants: Further Particulars

The Society makes grants twice every year towards research into architectural history. These grants are open to application from all, including non-members. The SAHGB acknowledges and thanks the late Margaret Ramsden and other donors; grants for research into C16 & C17 architectural history are made in memory of the late [Annabel Ricketts](#).

### Scope

Research grants may cover:

- travel
- building survey
- photography

Research grants may not cover:

- maintenance at home
- purchase of books or equipment
- secretarial help
- conference attendance

### Conditions

The applicant must be intending to publish the results of his or her research or to present them at an academic conference

The application must say why the research should be funded – what is new?

No-one can receive more than two grants of the same type

Priority will be given to applicants resident in the United Kingdom or working on the history of the architecture of the United Kingdom, or any part of it

Priority will be given to postgraduate students and those within five years of completing a postgraduate degree

Priority will be given to first-time applicants

The grant must be acknowledged in the resulting publication or thesis

A grant will frequently be only a contribution towards the applicant's costs

All grants are made and payable in sterling

Grants should be claimed within 3 years of being awarded, and will lapse without notice unless an extension is requested and granted.

### Amount Awarded

Individual awards do not normally exceed £500, but in exceptional circumstances can be up to £1,000. Receipts are required before payment is made. In order to claim a grant, an applicant should have an active SAHGB membership (although this is not a pre-requisite for the initial application).

### Applications

To apply, use the SAHGB's Grant Application Form, available via the Funding page, to make an application to the [Secretary](#) by 1 May and 1 Oct; you should also ask two referees to send letters of support to the Secretary, to arrive by these dates.
